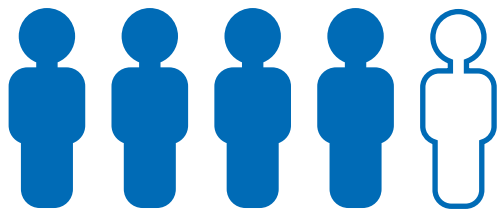


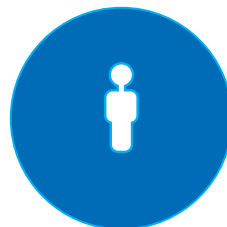
The Impact of COVID 19 on people with disabilities



Four in five people with disabilities say COVID-19 has negatively impacted them

Most common impacts of COVID 19 on people with disabilities

Isolation/lack of social interactions



Employment/financial



Mental health



Overall health and wellbeing for people with disabilities is 21% worse than before COVID-19

Mental and emotional wellbeing for people with disabilities is 23% worse than before COVID-19

Financial situation for people with disabilities is 24% worse than before COVID-19

- ▶ Four in five people with disabilities say COVID-19 has negatively impacted them
- ▶ Top three negative impacts: Isolation/lack of social interactions / Employment/financial impact / Mental health impact
- ▶ Overall health and wellbeing for people with disabilities is 21% worse than before COVID-19
- ▶ Mental and emotional wellbeing for people with disabilities is 23% worse than before COVID-19
- ▶ Financial situation for people with disabilities is 24% worse than before COVID-19
